Vittorio Scardaci is one of the winners of the Graduate Student Award at the European Materials Research Society (EMRS) Spring Meeting 2007 for his work on "Carbon Nanotubes for Photonic Devices".

The award consisted in the waiving of the conference fees and a prize of 110 euros. The conference was held in Strasbourg (France) from May 28th to june 1st, and joined worldwide scientists from the material science community.

He says: "I'm very grateful to have been recognized for the high value of the work, carried out at the Department of Engineering under the supervision of Dr Andrea C. Ferrari, and in particular for the high potential of carbon nanotubes to impact future technologies in telecommunications.
